

ORDINANCE NO. 919

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTERS 3, 11, 14, 17, 24 AND 29 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ESCANABA.

THE CITY OF ESCANABA ORDAINS:

CHAPTER I

Section 1. Addition of New Section 3-50.

A new Section, Section 3-50, is added to the Code of Ordinances to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 3-50 - Penalties and Sanctions.

Municipal Civil Infraction. A person who violates any provision of Chapter 3 is responsible for a municipal civil infraction subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars plus costs and other sanctions for each infraction. Repeat offenses shall be subject to all of the provisions of Section 1-13 of this Code.

Section 2. Addition of New Section 11-10.

A new Section, Section 11-10, is added to the Code of Ordinances to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 11-10 - Penalties and Sanctions.

Municipal Civil Infraction. A person who violates any provision of Chapter 11 is responsible for a municipal civil infraction subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars plus costs and other sanctions for each infraction. Repeat offenses shall be subject to all of the provisions of Section 1-13 of this Code.

Section 3. Addition of New Section 14-60.

A new Section, Section 14-60, is added to the Code of Ordinances to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 14-60 - Penalties and Sanctions.

Municipal Civil Infraction. A person who violates any provision of Chapter 14 is responsible for a municipal civil infraction subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars plus costs and other sanctions for each infraction. Repeat offenses shall be subject to all of the provisions of Section 1-13 of this Code.

Section 4. Addition of New Section 17-90.

A new Section, Section 17-90, is added to the Code of Ordinances to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 17-90 - Penalties and Sanctions.

Municipal Civil Infraction. A person who violates any provision of Chapter 17 is responsible for a municipal civil infraction subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars plus costs and other sanctions for each infraction. Repeat offenses shall be subject to all of the provisions of Section 1-13 of this Code.

Section 5. Addition of New Section 24-60.

A new Section, Section 24-60, is added to the Code of Ordinances to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 24-60 - Penalties and Sanctions.

Municipal Civil Infraction. A person who violates any provision of Chapter 24 is responsible for a municipal civil infraction subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars plus costs and other sanctions for each infraction. Repeat offenses shall be subject to all of the provisions of Section 1-13 of this Code.

Section 6. Addition of New Section 29-20.

A new Section, Section 29-20, is added to the Code of Ordinances to read in its entirety as follows:

follows:

Section 29-20 - Penalties and Sanctions.

Municipal Civil Infraction. A person who violates any provision of Chapter 29 is responsible for a municipal civil infraction subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars plus costs and other sanctions for each infraction. Repeat offenses shall be subject to all of the provisions of Section 1-13 of this Code.

CHAPTER II

SAVINGS CLAUSE

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of the within Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.

CHAPTER III

REPEALING CHAPTER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER IV

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its passage and publication.
