NOTICE FOR EXCAVATIONS

Act 53 of Public Acts of 1974 requires that all persons obtaining excavation permits be notified that they must comply with the provisions of that Act.

- 1. Any person causing an excavation to be made (including non-powered tools) shall comply with the provisions to notify the respective utilities of their intent to excavate, at least 72 hours in advance.

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CITY OF ESCANABA CONSTRUCTION GUIDELINES

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Property Owner/Contractor will be responsible for damage to any existing walks, curbs, pavement, lawns, etc. and will be required to replace/repair to existing or better condition. All repair activities should be coordinated with the City of Escanaba Engineering Department. It is the Property Owner/Contractor's responsibility to make sure all work is in compliance with MIOSHA safety standards and standard construction practices. The City of Escanaba reserves the right to stop any and all work if the Property Owner/Contractor is not in compliance with the guidelines of the Street Occupancy and Excavation Permit.

FEES

If this permit is applied for prior to the start of any construction activity, the Permit fee shall be \$20.00. If any construction activity has started prior to this permit application, a Permit Fee of \$100.00 shall be imposed. Additional fees may be imposed at the discretion of the City of Escanaba. Items of work that require inspection outside of normal City of Escanaba business hours will be assessed an additional fee. The City of Escanaba's business hours are from 7:30-4:00, Monday thru Friday.

TIME OF COMPLETION

All work shall be done within the dates specified on the Excavation/Right-of-Way Construction Permit. This is to include restoration of all areas affected by permitted activities. Failure to comply with the time constraints setup within the permit, without prior notification to the City of Escanaba Engineering Department, may result in the suspension of all work on the site. The City of Escanaba, at its discretion, will deem the best solution to complete the permitted work. This may include the City of Escanaba completing the permitted work and charging the Property Owner on a time and materials basis.

SITE PLAN

A site plan may be required to process a Excavation/Right-of-Way Construction Permit. The site plan should show all existing conditions and proposed changes if applicable.

INSPECTION

Inspection of underground utilities must be made before backfilling. Please contact the City of Escanaba Engineering Department to coordinate inspection. Inspection of other permitted activities may also be required. The City of Escanaba will, at its discretion, decide when an inspection is warranted.

BACKFILLING

All excavations shall be backfilled according to the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) 2012 Standard Specifications for Construction or the latest revision. This includes:

- 1. Backfill using only clean fill.
- 2. Compact sub-base (sand) in lifts not to exceed 12 inches.
- 3. Compacting sub-base (sand) to 95 percent of the maximum unit weight for its entire thickness, density tests may be required at the Property Owner/Contractor's expense.
- 4. Match the existing depth of base (gravel). Provide at a minimum 6 inches of compacted MDOT 22A gravel.
- Compacting base (gravel) in lifts not to exceed 6 inches.
- 6. Compacting base (gravel) to 98 percent of the maximum unit weight for its entire thickness, density tests may be required at the Property Owner/Contractor's expense.
- 7. Provide a 3 inch thick Hot Mix Asphalt patch for all excavations within a paved street. When Hot Mix Asphalt is not readily available the excavation must be filled with a sufficient thickness of Cold Patch to maintain a smooth riding surface until 3 inches of Hot Mix Asphalt can be laid. The City of Escanaba will at the Property Owner/Contractor's expense provide temporary and permanent patching on a time a material basis.

SIGNAGE AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

The property owner/contractor is required to have proper signs and traffic control devices for the permitting construction activities. When construction signs are required, a signage plan shall be submitted with the application. All signage shall conform to the Michigan Department of Transportation Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices Revised 2011 Edition.

Safe traffic flow shall be maintained at all times during construction. If a detour or lane closure is required for the permitted activity a Maintenance of Traffic Plan shall be submitted with the permit. The Maintenance of Traffic Plan shall conform to the Michigan Department of Transportation Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices Revised 2011 Edition.

It is the Property Owner/Contractor's responsibility to maintain and monitor all construction signs during the course of the permitted activity and to remove the signs at the completion of the work.
