

NEW BUSINESS

Discussion – Superior Trade Corridor Next Michigan Development Corporation

The City Council and Administration discussed a draft interlocal agreement which created the Superior Trade Corridor Next Michigan Development Corporation and a resolution to adopt the agreement so that the City of Escanaba becomes a voting participant in the Superior Trade Zone. The following discussion took place:

- Manager reviewed History of a Regional Trade Zone to foster economic opportunities and obtain grant incentives for new business and to expand current businesses;
- Reviewed process to create Articles of Incorporation for the Superior Trade Zone and its approval. Once approved by the State, a corporation could be formed that could take advantage of tax cuts and State funds aimed to encourage investment, job creation and retention, and other economic growth;
- Reviewed benefits of a Trade Zone which would allow trade zone members to apply with the MEDC for various benefits;
- Articles of Incorporation Allows Corporation members veto power if they were a member. It also allowed members to opt out of projects;

- City of Marquette and Marquette County have approved and passed Articles of Incorporation and Resolution to create the Superior Trade Zone;
- On behalf of Delta County, a 2% grant with the Hannahville Indian Community was made to help Delta County, Cities and Townships pay for their application fee. The application fee for the City of Escanaba of \$1,250 would be sent to Council for final approval;
- Reviewed recruitment possibilities and grant incentives that could be used to attract businesses.

It was Council consensus to direct Administration to add this item to the September 4th Council Agenda to approve a resolution adopting an Intergovernmental Agreement to create the Superior Trade Zone under the Urban Cooperation Act, and to authorize \$1,250 application fee.

Update – Sale of the Power Plant – City Manager’s Office.

Manager O’Toole provided an update on Escanaba Green Energy financial update, and latest developments related to the sale of the Escanaba generating facility.

Approval – Superior Trade Zone Next Michigan Development Corporation Bylaws.

Administration requested Council approve a resolution to adopt an intergovernmental agreement to create the Superior Trade Zone under the Urban Planning Act and to authorize the administration to spend up to \$1250 for the required

Manager O'Toole stated the City Council was being asked to approve a resolution which would make the City of Escanaba a founding and voting member of the Superior Trade Zone Next Michigan Development Corporation under the Urban Cooperation Act.

The Superior Trade Zone was being created between the units of government in Delta County and Marquette County so that a positive business environment and strong regional economic foundation existed which would expand, retain and recruit new business to the central region of the Upper Peninsula.

Representatives from the City of Escanaba, City of Gladstone, Delta County, the Delta County units of government in Delta County along with our counterparts in Marquette County and the City of Marquette have been working on this strategy to work together with the State of Michigan to market opportunities in our region which will promote economic growth, and expand business growth, transportation infrastructure, marketing and added investment incentives. Collectively it was the groups opinion that overtime as a city and as a region we will see the acceleration of business growth which was consistent with community goals and objectives to provide jobs to residents, make efficient use of existing resources, improve infrastructure and promote the use of regional assets.

NB-6 By Council Member Sattem, seconded by Council Member Beauchamp, to authorize Administration to spend up to \$1250 for the required MEDC application filing fee, and formerly adopt the following resolution:

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT TO
CREATE THE SUPERIOR TRADE ZONE UNDER THE URBAN COOPERATION ACT**

**CITY OF ESCANABA
SEPTEMBER 4, 2014**

WHEREAS, subject to the approval of the Michigan Strategic Fund (the "MSF"), the Next Michigan Development Act, 2010 P.A. 275, MCL as amended by PA 238 and PA 239 of 2013, allows for the creation of a Next Michigan Development Corporation ("NMDC") among local government parties for economic development purposes; and

WHEREAS, Act 275 provides, in part, that there first be in place an Interlocal Agreement under the Urban Cooperation Act of 1967, 1967 P.A. 7, MCL 124.501-512 ("ACT 7"); and

WHEREAS, it is further provided in Act 275 that the Act 7 Interlocal Agreement be approved by the Governor of the State of Michigan before submitted to the MSF; and

WHEREAS, the City of Escanaba Council has been presented an Interlocal Agreement creating the Superior Trade Zone Next Michigan Development Corporation (the

“Interlocal Agreement”) for economic development purposes and deems it to be in the best interest of the City of Escanaba to approve the Interlocal Agreement and become a voting participant in the Superior Trade Zone.

WHEREAS, the acceleration of business growth in Delta and Marquette Counties is consistent with community goals and objectives to provide jobs for residents, make efficient use of existing resources, improve infrastructure and promote the use of regional assets as provided for in comprehensive regional plans; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Escanaba City Council, Michigan, hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager and/or City Clerk is authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement on behalf of the City of Escanaba Michigan, and to consent to non-material adjustments and corrections to the Interlocal Agreement as may be required by the State of Michigan officers and agencies.

Michigan Municipal League Annual Meeting Notice

(Please present at the next Council, Commission or Board Meeting)

Dear Official:

The Michigan Municipal League Annual Convention will be held in Marquette, October 15-17, 2014. The League's "Annual Meeting" is scheduled for 11:15 am on Thursday, October 16 in the Lakes Ballroom at the Northern Michigan University. The meeting will be held for the following purposes:

1. Election of Trustees. To elect six members of the Board of Trustees for terms of three years each (see #1 on page 2).
2. Policy. A) To vote on the Core Legislative Principles document.
In regard to the proposed League Core Legislative Principles, the document is available on the League website at <http://www.mml.org/delegate>. If you would like to receive a copy of the proposed principles by fax, please call Susan Vasher at the League at 800-653-2483.

B) If the League Board of Trustees has presented any resolutions to the membership, they also will be voted on. (See #2 on page 2.)
In regard to resolutions, member municipalities planning on submitting resolutions for consideration by the League Trustees are reminded that under the Bylaws, they must be submitted to the Trustees for their review by September 16, 2014.
3. Other Business. To transact such other business as may properly come before the meeting.

Designation of Voting Delegates

Pursuant to the provisions of the League Bylaws, you are requested to designate by action of your governing body one of your officials who will be in attendance at the Convention as your official representative to cast the vote of the municipality at the Annual Meeting, and, if possible, to designate one other official to serve as alternate. Please submit this information through the League website by visiting <http://www.mml.org/delegate> no later than September 24, 2014.

Regarding the designation of an official representative of the member to the annual meeting, please note the following section of the League Bylaws:

"Section 4.4 - Votes of Members. Each member shall be equally privileged with all other members in its voice and vote in the election of officers and upon any proposition presented for discussion or decision at any meeting of the members. Honorary members shall be entitled to participate in the discussion of any question, but such members shall not be entitled to vote. The vote of each member shall be cast by its official representative attending the meeting at which an election of officers or a decision on any proposition shall take place. Each member shall, by action of its governing body prior to the annual meeting or any special meeting, appoint one official of such member as its principal official representative to cast the vote of the member at such meeting, and may appoint one official as its alternate official representative to serve in the absence or inability to act of the principal representative."

1. Election of Trustees

Regarding election of Trustees, under Section 5.3 of the League Bylaws, six members of the Board of Trustees will be elected at the annual meeting for a term of three years. The regulations of the Board of Trustees require the Nominations Committee to complete its recommendations and post the names of the nominees for the Board of Trustees on a board at the registration desk at least four hours before the hour of the business meeting.

2. Statements of Policy and Resolutions

Regarding consideration of resolutions and statements of policy, under Section 4.5 of the League Bylaws, the Board of Trustees acts as the Resolutions Committee, and "no resolution or motion, except procedural and incidental matters having to do with business properly before the annual meeting or pertaining to the conduct of the meeting, shall be considered at the annual meeting unless it is either (1) submitted to the meeting by the Board of Trustees, or (2) submitted in writing to the Board of Trustees by resolution of the governing body of a member at least thirty (30) days preceding the date of the annual meeting." Thus the deadline this year for the League to receive resolutions is **September 16, 2014**. Please submit resolutions to the attention of Daniel P. Gilmartin, Executive Director/CEO at 1675 Green Rd., Ann Arbor, MI 48105. Any resolution submitted by a member municipality will go to the League Board of Trustees, serving as the resolutions committee under the Bylaws, which may present it to the membership at the Annual Meeting or refer it to the appropriate policy committee for additional action.


Further, "Every proposed resolution submitted by a member shall be stated in clear and concise language and shall be accompanied by a statement setting forth the reasons for recommending the proposed resolution. The Board shall consider the proposal at a Board meeting prior to the next annual meeting and, after consideration, shall make a recommendation as to the advisability of adopting each such resolution or modification thereof."

3. Posting of Proposed Resolutions and Core Legislative Principles

The proposed Michigan Municipal League Core Legislative Principles and any new proposed Resolutions recommended by the Board of Trustees for adoption by the membership will be available on the League website, or at the League registration desk to permit governing bodies of member communities to have an opportunity to review such proposals and delegate to their voting representative the responsibility for expressing the official point of view of the member at the Annual Meeting.

The Board of Trustees will meet on Wednesday, October 15 in the Lakes Ballroom at Northern Michigan University for the purpose of considering such other matters as may be requested by the membership, in addition to other agenda items.


