### APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

Evans moved, Hellerman seconded, **CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**, to approve the minutes of February 27, 2012, as printed.

### NEW BUSINESS

- (1) **REQUEST TO TRANSFER OWNERSHIP OF AN ESCROWED 2010 CLASS C LICENSED BUSINESS WITH ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT, LOCATED AT 1282 OLD US 2 & 41, BARK RIVER, MI 49807, BARK RIVER TOWNSHIP, DELTA COUNTY FROM HYSLOP ENTERPRISES, INC. TO UPPER PENINSULA STATE FAIR AUTHORITY; TRANSFER LOCATION (GOVERNMENTAL UNIT) MCL 436.1531(1) TO 2401 S TWELFTH ESCANABA, MI 49829, DELTA COUNTY. CANCEL ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT. REQUEST NEW DANCE-ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT.**

Upper Peninsula State Fair Authority representative Vicky Micheau was in attendance and provided the Board the intentions for the State Fair property. Ms. Micheau explained changes made to the permit request to cancel: Living Quarters Permit, Entertainment permit, and Special Purpose permit, and to add New Sunday Sales (PM), Dance-Entertainment, Special Purpose Permit (Events 24hrs), add Bars (2) a total of 3 Bars, (Ruth Butler Building, Grand Stand, and UP Steam and Gas Village), and Direct Connections (7). Ms. Micheau stated all changes were made with approval from the State of Michigan, and City Public Safety Department. Ms. Micheau stated the liquor license would allow more events to take place on the Fairground property, and explained how UP Fair Administration would work with local Non-profit organizations with events on the Fairgrounds property.

**NB-1** After further review and discussion, Evans moved, Hellerman seconded, **CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**, to recommend the Escanaba City Council approve a request to transfer ownership of an escrowed 2010 Class C Licensed Business with Entertainment Permit, located at 1282 Old US 2 & 41, Bark River, MI 49807, Bark River Township, Delta County from Hyslop Enterprises, Inc. to Upper Peninsula State Fair Authority; transfer location (governmental unit) MCL 436.1531(1) to 2401

N Twelfth Escanaba, MI 49829, Delta County, to cancel: Living Quarters Permit, Entertainment permit, and Special Purpose permit, and to add New Sunday Sales (PM), Dance-Entertainment, Special Purpose Permit (Events 24hrs), add Bars (2) a total of 3 Bars, (Ruth Butler Building, Grand Stand, and UP Gas and Light Village, and Direct Connections (7).
